

Modbook Software Bundle for Yosemite – ReadMe

This bundle includes two software pieces, plus instructions:

- Modbook_Yosemite_readme.pdf (these instructions)
- ModbookPen_5.3.6-5.dmg (pen tablet software installer)
- ModbookSystem_1.1.0.pkg (system software installer)

You can install these two software pieces either before or after upgrading your system to OS X 10.10 Yosemite. However, we recommend installing them before the OS X upgrade.

(Note: You may have to change your security settings to install this software. Go to **Apple menu > System Preferences > Security & Privacy > General**. At lower left, press "Click the lock to make changes." Enter password. Under "Allow applications downloaded from," select "Anywhere.")

Please read these instructions carefully. **You must *uninstall* the previous version of the Modbook Pen Tablet Software *before* installing the new version (see below).**

Part 1 of 3: Installing the Modbook Pen Tablet Software

Product	Modbook® Pen Tablet Software
Version	5.3.6-5
OS Compatibility	OS X® 10.9.x Mavericks, OS X 10.10.x Yosemite
System Requirements	Modbook Pen Tablet Software (version 5.3.6-5) requires the following hardware: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Modbook Pro (approximately 59.6 MB of free disk space is required for installation)
Instructions	<p>Important: You must <i>uninstall</i> the previous version of the Modbook Pen Tablet Software <i>before</i> installing this new version (Step #1 and #2).</p> <p>Step #1 – UNINSTALL Go to Finder > Applications > Modbook Pen, and double-click Modbook Pen Utility to start the utility. In the Modbook Pen Utility, you'll see "Tablet Software:" followed by a "Remove" button. Click THAT "Remove" button (not the "Remove" button at the top of the pane). You may have to enter your password to allow this change. This should completely remove the Pen Tablet Software from your system.</p> <p>Step #2 – CONFIRM UNINSTALL To confirm you removed the previous version, go to Apple menu > System Preferences. Scroll to the bottom of System Preferences. "Modbook Pen" should no longer appear there.</p> <p>Step #3 To install the new pen tablet software, double-click on ModbookPen_5.3.6-5.dmg which you previously downloaded. Then double-click on Install Modbook Pen.pkg. Follow the prompts to install the software. You may need to enter your password for installation.</p> <p>Step #4 Once the installation is finished, go to Apple menu > System Preferences > Modbook Pen and click the "About" button. (If the Modbook Pen preferences aren't visible, remember to press the Mod Key button: http://www.modbook.com/support/kb/what-is-mod-key) If the version number is 5.3.6-5, then you've correctly installed the new version of the software.</p>

Part 2 of 3: Installing the Modbook System Software

Product	Modbook System Software (includes QuickClicks™ and QuickFlip™)
Version	1.1.0
OS Compatibility	OS X 10.9.x Mavericks, OS X 10.10.x Yosemite
System Requirements	Modbook System Software (version 1.1.0) requires the following hardware: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Modbook Pro (approximately 2.1 MB of free disk space is required for installation)
Instructions	<p>Note: You do NOT need to uninstall the previous version. The software installer will overwrite any previous version of the Modbook System Software.</p> <p>Step #1 To install the new system software, double-click on ModbookSystem_1.1.0.pkg which you previously downloaded. Follow the prompts to install the software. You may need to enter your password for installation. When completed, restart the system.</p> <p>Step #2 Once the system is restarted, go to Apple menu > System Preferences > Modbook System > About. If the version number is 1.1.0, then you've correctly installed the new version of the software.</p>

Part 3 of 3: Upgrading to Yosemite

Now that you've installed the new Modbook Pen Tablet Software and Modbook System Software, you are almost ready to upgrade your system to Yosemite. On the Modbook Pro or any other Mac® system, **remember to do a complete backup of your system using Time Machine® before you upgrade OS X.**

To upgrade, follow the same instructions for any other Mac: <http://www.apple.com/osx/how-to-upgrade/> Since Yosemite is a large download, you may want to position your device as close as possible to your internet router to speed the download process.

Final Note: El Capitan and future versions of OS X

This software may NOT be compatible with OS X version 10.11 El Capitan or future versions of OS X.

We do not recommend upgrading your Modbook Pro to El Capitan or later OS X versions until checking to see if they are supported at <http://www.modbook.com/support>.
